

2008 Lorain International Princess Pageant

Official Rules and Regulations

1. Pageant will be held on Thursday, June 26, 2008 at the Lorain Palace Civic Center
2. Entrant must be a resident of Lorain County (Including the entire city of Vermilion) for one year
3. Entrant must have completed her junior year of High School by June, 2008. Participant may have to provide proof of transcript and/or report card at the discretion of the Princess Pageant Committee. Participant may be single, never married or divorced, had a marriage annulled, pregnant, or an unwed mother, and not be of an age exceed 24 by June 26, 2008.
4. Entrant may be proposed as a princess for not more than two years, one year if elected Queen.
5. Entrant must not participate in another pageant from January 1 to June 30, 2008. If elected to the court, the commitment is extended to June 30, 2008. Court must participate in a minimum of 6 Ohio Festival and Events Association parades as prescribed by the Princess Pageant Committee in order to receive awards and scholarships.
6. Entrant agrees to abide by all the rules now in effect, or as announced hereafter by the Princess Pageant Committee. Final acceptance of entrants at the discretion of the Princess Pageant Committee.
7. Entrants will be required to sell Princess Pageant tickets. Each princess is also required to have a non-profit sponsor. Cost to the sponsor is \$50.00 per princess, due at orientation on Saturday, March 15, 2008.
8. Entrant's costume must be ready by April 11th, 2008.
9. Each princess will be required to attend, in costume, the following activities: Princess Reception, Parade, International Breakfast, Sacred Music Night, Outdoor Concert, Festival and Bazaar, opening ceremony, all rehearsals, daily appearances during the festival and bazaar, and a majority of the outside activities before and after the pageant.
10. Entrant agrees that the time, manner, and method of judging shall be solely within the discretion of the Princess Pageant Committee. The decision will be final. Judges are members of the All American Judges Association and are secured from outside the Lorain County area.
11. Entrant agrees that if she is selected as the winner of the Pageant, she will not sign a management contract with any written or verbal endorsement of any mercantile commodity or commercial organization, nor will she permit any photographs to be used in connection with any advertised commodity or service not associated with this contest without written permission of the Princess Pageant Committee. If all obligations of the Queen and/or Court are not met, each will be subject to loss of awards and scholarship monies.
